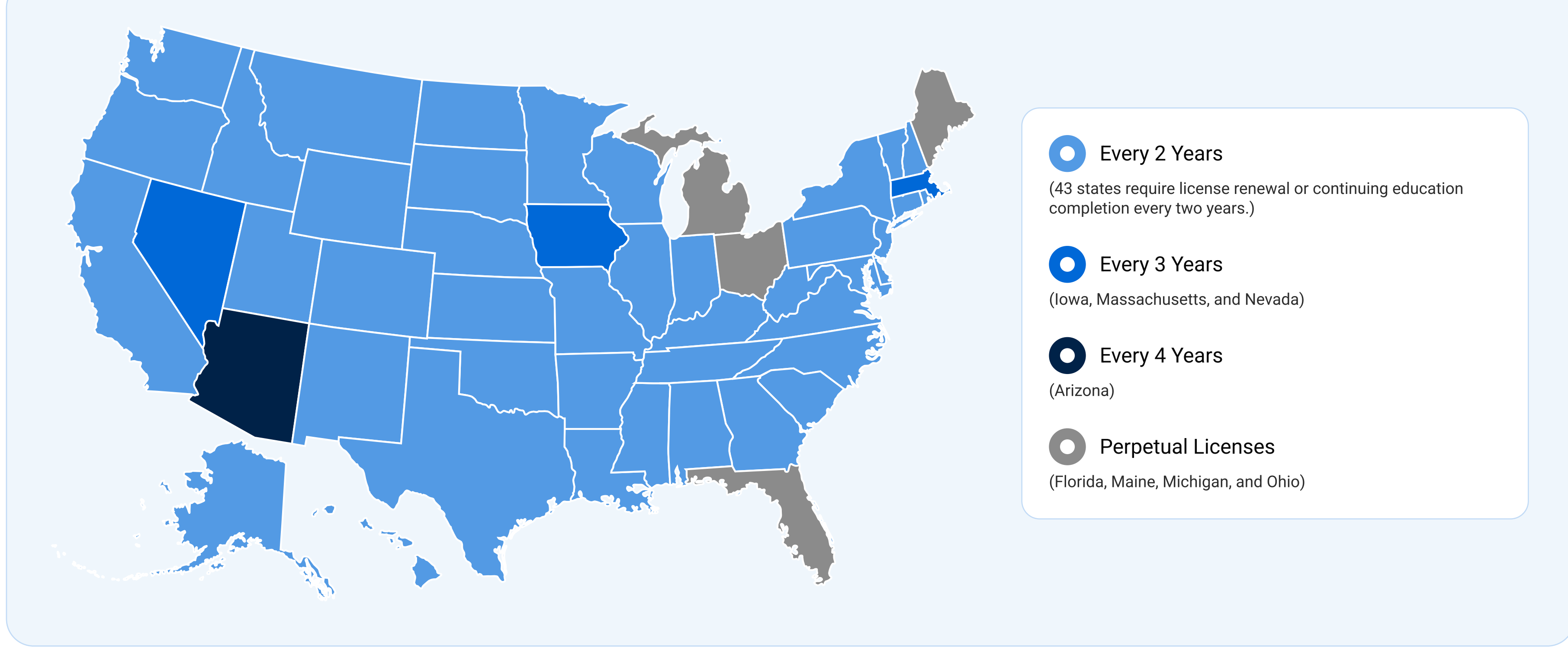


Insurance Licensing Across All 50 States — At a Glance

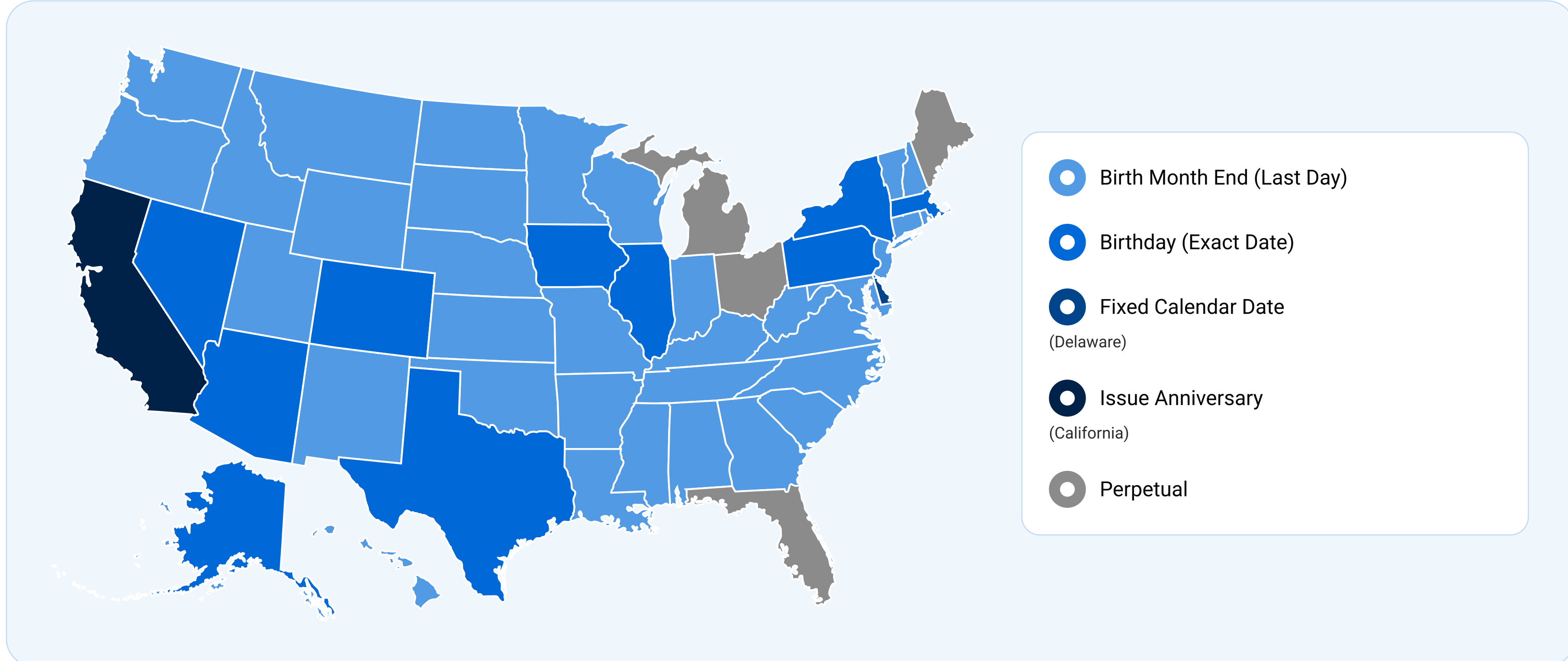

How insurance producer licenses renew across all 50 states

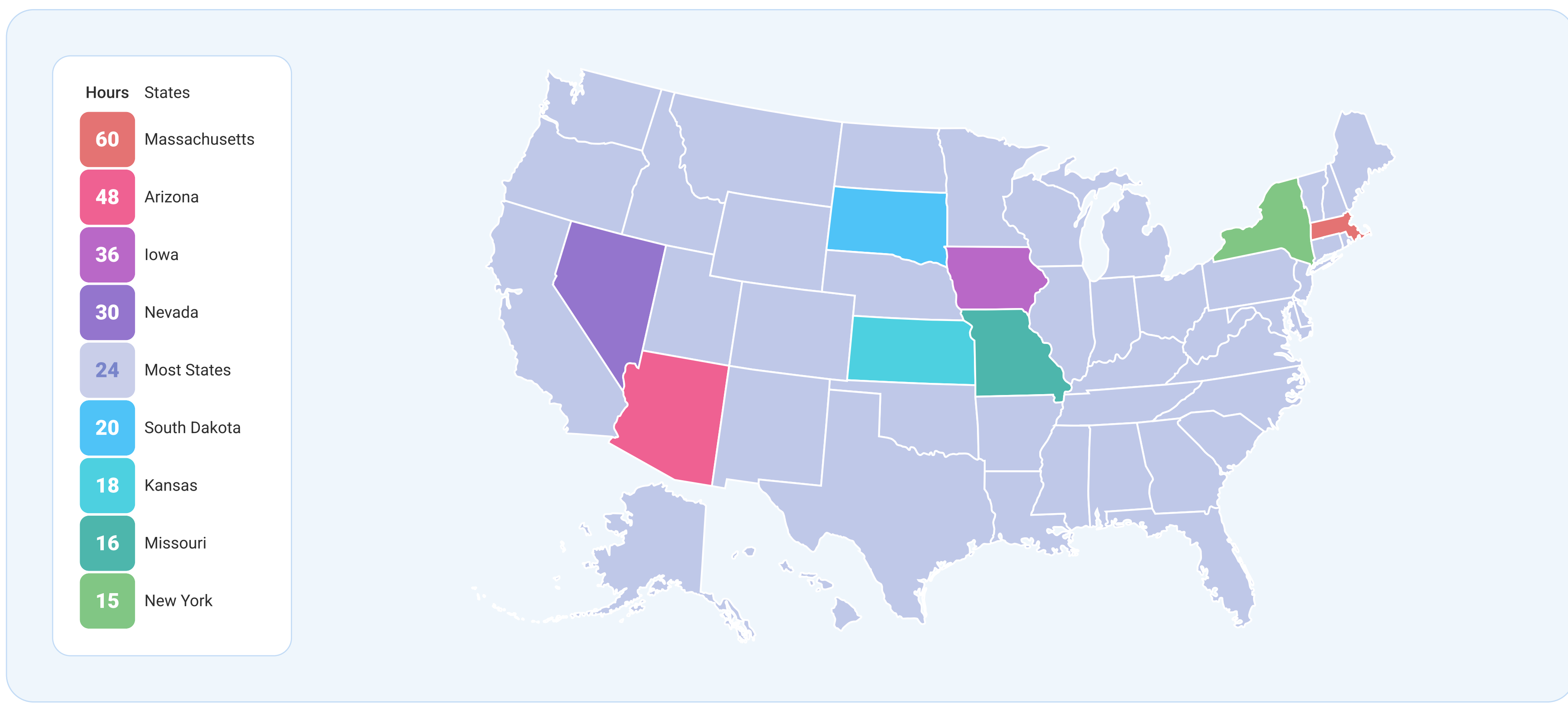


When does your license actually expire?

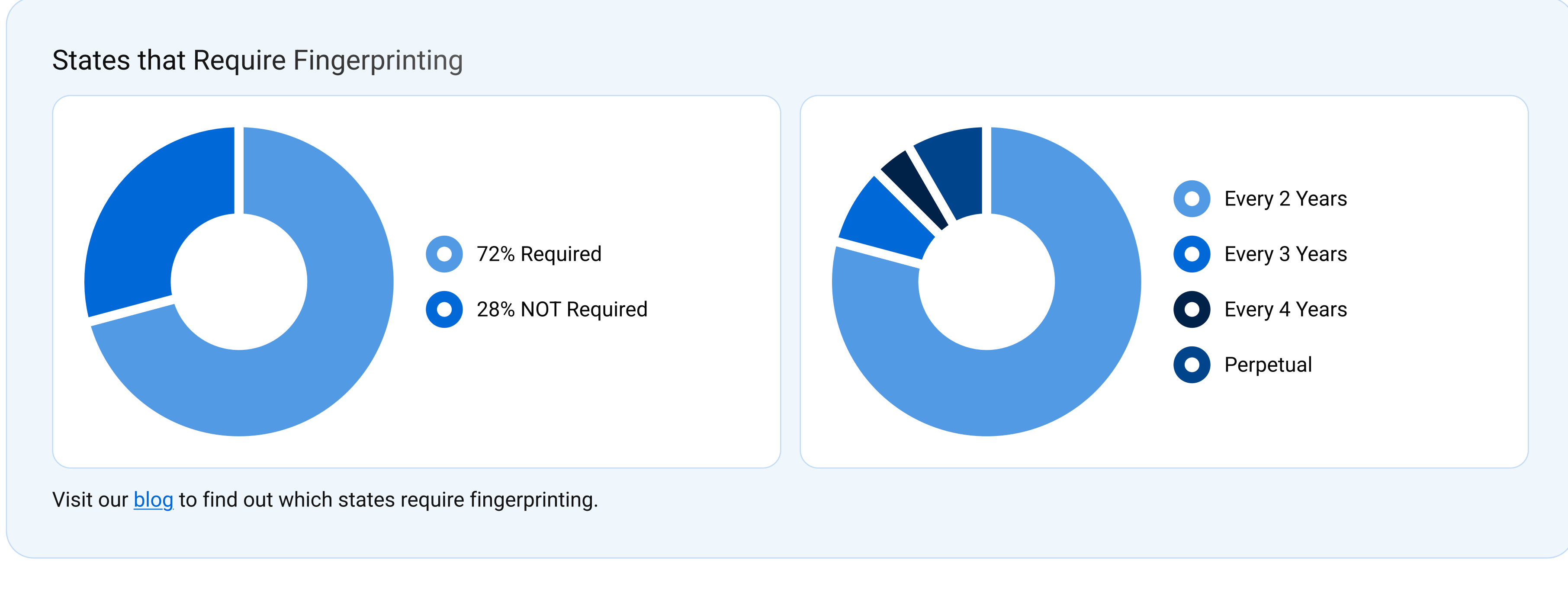
Renewal frequency tells you how often, but the trigger date tells you exactly when.



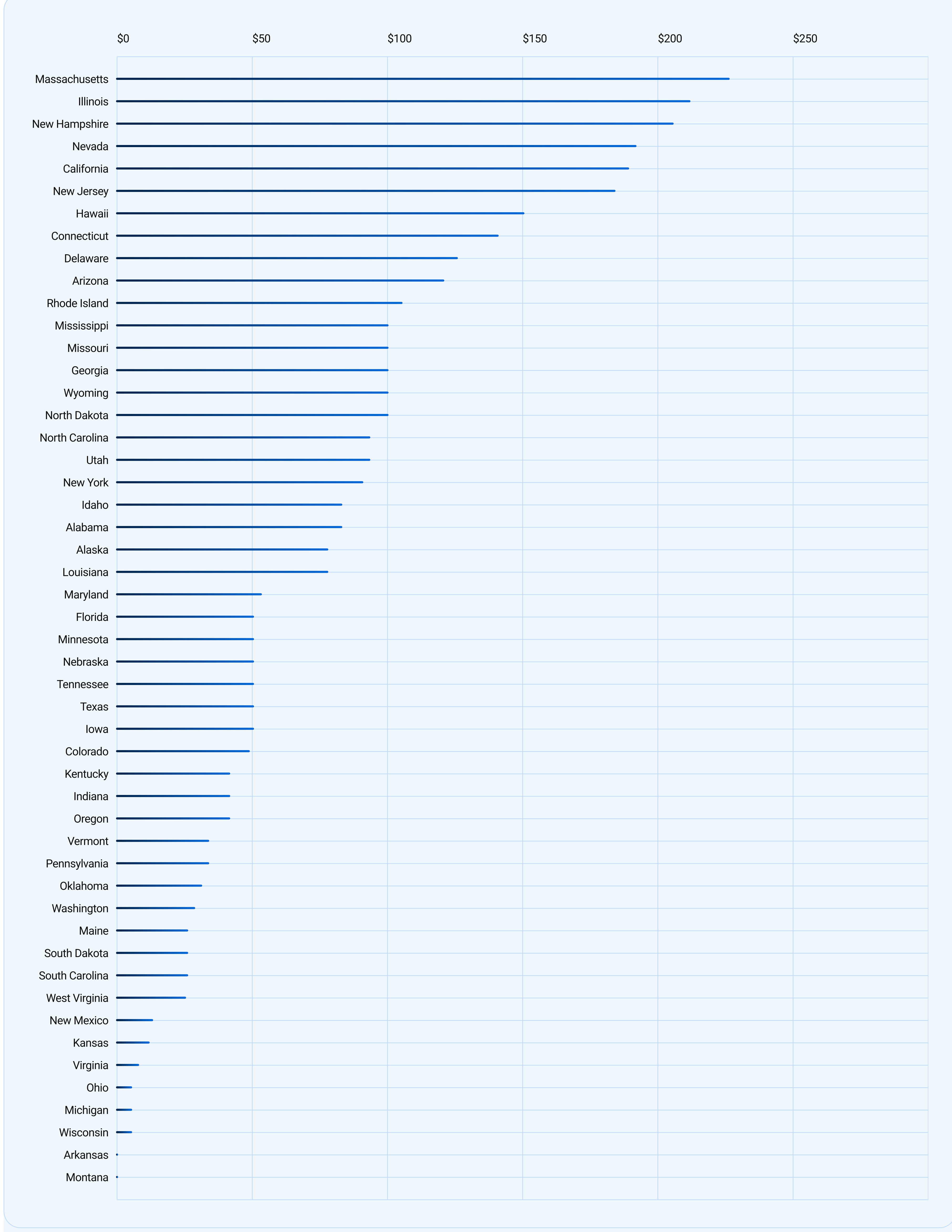
Continuing Education By State



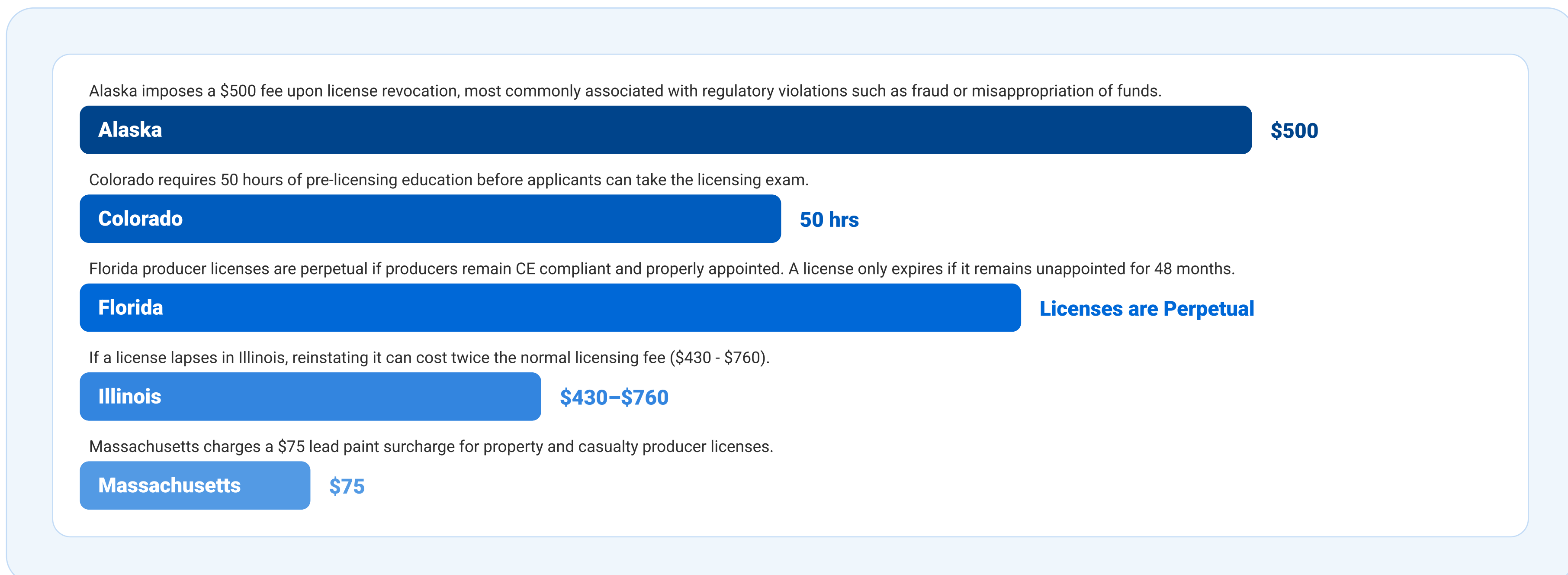
Fingerprinting By the Numbers



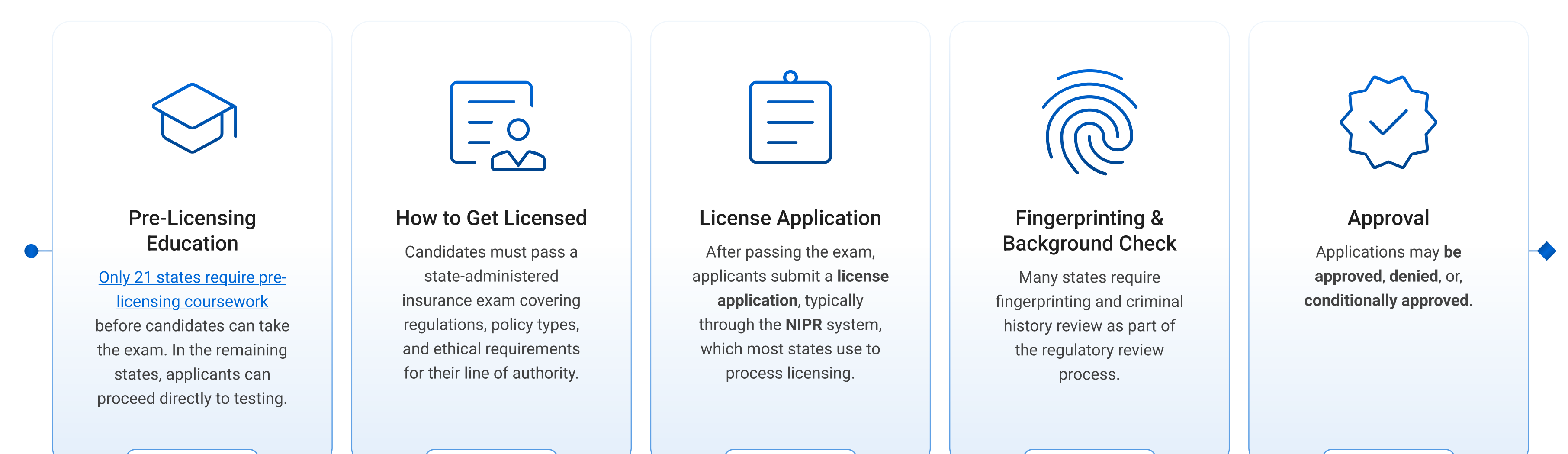
